Fabric: Good quality 100% cotton

- Front: .8m / in a solid or tone on tone.
- Binding: .3m (Not needed for class)

Batting

- (.6 m) Warm and Natural or Warm and Plush (Minimum 22" x 32")

Thread

- One spool good quality 50 weight cotton
- Please pre-wind two bobbins

Needles

- 90/14 Quilting or 80/12 Topstitch

Additional Supplies

- Quilting Gloves (Optional but helpful)
- 24" Quilting ruler for marking lines and grids.
- Quilters marking tool that is clearly visible on your chosen fabric.
(Please test prior to class be sure that it will mark as well as remove easily.)
- Quilters safety pins.

JAPANESE FOLDED PATCHWORK: QUILT AS YOU GO

3 Hour Workshop

Bring to Class:

- About 2 metres of coordinating or contrasting coloured fabric like florals, tone on tone, batiks etc. A variety of fabrics will give a very interesting effect. (Note: in order to make a completed quilt you will need additional yardage)
- ½ metre of batting approx. 54 inches wide or several scraps from previous projects. (Pieces need to be at least 5" square)
- Template plastic or cardboard to make patterns (Cereal boxes work well as does sandpaper) Patterns are up to 8" in diameter so you will need 3 or 4
- Freezer paper (optional)
- Rotary
- Paper scissors
- Medium to large fabric scissors
- Matching thread for your project
- Compass to draw circles onto cardboard, or you can trace around mine

PANT ALTERATIONS AND KNOWING YOUR BODY MEASUREMENTS

SWEET AND SIMPLE 60 DEGREE TRIANGLE QUILT

THURSDAY 9:00 AM – 12:00 PM | AVIATION A3
3 Hour Workshop

"Bonnie Baby Quilt" (30.5" x 36.5" without borders or 36.5" x 42.5" with a 3" border)

In class you will learn how to cut 60 degree triangles using the lines on your 24" rotary ruler, how to pin and sew the resulting triangles into rows and how to assemble rows to complete the body of the quilt. Due to allotted time, students can expect to complete the cutting and sewing of up to two rows of your project as you perfect the skills required to complete at home.

Bring to class:

- **Fabric;** Good quality 100 % cotton
 - (.2 m) of ten different fabrics -or- .4 m of five different fabrics -or- .2 m of five different fabrics plus 1.0 m of a plain or tone on tone.
 - (.4 m) for optional border (cut four strips 3 ½" wide) *Not needed for class.
 - (.3 m) for binding (cut four strips 2 ½" wide) *Not needed for class.
- **Additional Supplies**
 - Size 75/11 Quilting Needles or 80/12 Jeans Denim Needles
 - 50 weight cotton thread to blend with the color of your fabric.
 - 45 mm Rotary Cutter
 - Cutting Mat
 - 24" Rotary Ruler. Must have 60Degree and 30 Degree lines.
 - Marking tool of your choice.

***Not needed for class.**

- Backing; 1.0 m for small size 1.3 m for larger quilt.
- Batting of your choice.

PAPER PERFECTION IN MINIATURE

3 Hour Workshop

(Finished Size: 6" x 8") This is a small project which looks best in a variety of small or tonal printed fabrics.

For some fun features you can select fabric such as small stripes that may resemble thread, or browns to resemble wood for the spools.

Bring to class:

- Block Background: Light Print Fabric: Select (1) single fabric or (12 or more) assorted light prints: For each fabric: 1 - 5" x 5" piece or larger; if using a single fabric choice you will require approx. 0.25m or 1 fat quarter
- Spools: Brown Printed Fabrics: Select (1) single fabric or (12 or more) assorted prints: For each fabric: 1 - 3" x 3" piece or larger; if using a single fabric choice you will require 0.25m or 1 fat quarter
- Threads: Assorted Colours Printed Fabrics: (12 or more) assorted prints and colours to represent threads: For each of (12) different fabrics: 1 - 5" x 5" piece or larger
- Small Heart: Red Printed Fabrics: (1) print or (6) or more assorted prints: For each fabric: 1 - 3" x 3" piece or larger; if using a single fabric choice you will require 3" x 20" strip or equivalent.
- Large Heart: Red Printed Fabric: (1) print. For this fabric: 5" x 5" piece or larger

Please bring extra fabric pieces of those chosen above and some additional fabrics choices in case you wish to change your mind – it happens!

Notions:

- Add-An-Eighth Ruler by CM Designs (this is a blue/green coloured ruler)
- 6" Metal ruler (i.e. from Staples and please remove the cork and glue from the back for use in class)
- Rotary cutter, mat and ruler (recommended a small square ruler i.e. 4"x4" or 4.5" x 4.5" or 6"x 6") The

smaller size is best for working on small scale projects.

- Straight Pins
- Paper scissors
- Stiletto or similar to guide fabric under the sewing foot while sewing.
- Thread: neutral coordinating thread colour for use in the sewing machine

ORNAMENT FINISHING FOR NEEDLEWORK

SATURDAY 3:00 PM – 5:00 PM | AVIATION B1

2 Hour Workshop

Kit Fee: \$10

Bring to class:

- One design of your choice, already stitched, to fit into a 3" circle or a 3" square (both shapes will be covered in class, but you will only have time to complete one); this design should be done on aida, evenweave or linen needlework fabric, not on canvas.
- Sewing fabric for the back of the ornament (5"x5" or two pieces if you have an open space in your needlework, like the one in the model); I have used quilting cotton, lining fabric, satin, dupioni silk. Thin (but not sheer) fabrics work best; bulky fabrics won't work well.
- Sewing thread, any color
- Threads for making the cording and tassel for your ornament. Choose colors from the needlework piece you will be bringing. For the main color my first choice perle cotton (one ball of #8 will be enough), with floss as a second choice (several skeins of the same color will be required - bring at least 5 for the chosen color of your tassel). If you choose perle cotton for your main color, also bring 1 skein of floss that matches. For an accent color, almost any thread will work - floss or perle cotton again, metallic threads, needlepoint threads; you might want to bring two or three choices.
- Straight pins
- Glue stick
- Fabric scissors
- #24 or 26 tapestry needle
