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



TORONTO GUILD OF STITCHERY

Pat, Victoria, Nicole and Diane are experienced stitchers who are coming to you from the Toronto Guild of Stitchery, a chapter of the Embroiderers' Association of Canada. We are pleased to share some of our stitching ideas with you to give you a sample of some of the projects that are available through your local guild.



KALEIDOSCOPE STITCHING

Kaleidoscope stitching is the patterned placement of light and dark threads.

Create colourful repeating patterns using

only straight stitches and positioning coloured threads according to their shade or tone. In this class you will learn how to work a basic kaleidoscope block. 
